COMMUNIQUÉ OF THE COORDINATING BUREAU OF THE NON-ALIGNED MOVEMENT (NAM) ON THE COMMEMORATION OF THE 63^o ANNIVERSARY OF THE 1955 AFRO-ASIAN CONFERENCE OF BANDUNG

1. The Coordinating Bureau of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) celebrates the commemoration of the 63 Anniversary of the Afro-Asian Conference, held in 1955, in Bandung, Indonesia, which laid the basis for the establishment of the Movement and proclaimed the Bandung Principles, which constitute the main goals and objectives of the policy of non-alignment, and serve as the guides for its work and all its endeavors in the international arena.

The Coordinating Bureau of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) reaffirms its irrevocable political and moral commitment, as well as its determination to fully respect, preserve and act in accordance with the Bandung Principles and the purposes and principles of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) in the present international juncture, as agreed during both the XIV NAM Summit in Havana and the Bali Commemorative Declaration on the Fiftieth Anniversary of the Establishment of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM).

The Coordinating Bureau of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) renew its resolve to maintain, strengthen, and manifest the unity and solidarity, which are amongst its key values, among the membership of the Movement, and to continue making progress in the process of revitalizing and strengthening the Movement, particularly in relation to its efforts to enhance the status and role of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) as an anti-war peace-loving force.
